Resume Summary

Dr. Naresh Singh is currently the Director General for Governance and Social Development at CIDA's Policy Branch. He was Principal Adviser, Poverty and Sustainable Livelihoods, in the Bureau for Development Policy, UNDP, New York (1996-2001), and Director of the Poverty and Empowerment Program (1993-1996) at the International Institute for Sustainable Development in Winnipeg, Manitoba. He served as Senior Scientist and then Executive Director of the Caribbean Environmental Health Institute 1986 - 1993. He has worked internationally in more than 40 countries. He is also Adjunct Professor at Boston University, School of Public Health, and Visiting Scholar at Harvard University, Global Equity Initiative. He was Visiting Scholar at McGill University, International Development Studies (2003), and the Canada Trust Visiting Professor at the University of Waterloo, Faculty of Environmental Studies (2000-2001). He has served as an advisor to several organizations, including the Commonwealth Secretariat, London; the Pan American Health Organization, Washington, D.C., and the Foundation of International Environmental Law and Development, U.K. He is an Honorary Fellow of the Centre for International Sustainable Development Law at McGill University.

A graduate of the University of Guyana, he holds an MSc. from the Indian Agricultural Research Institute in New Delhi and a Ph.D. from the University of the West Indies in Jamaica. He is the author of over 100 contributions (journal articles, conference papers and books) on technical and policy issues related to the environment, poverty, natural resources and sustainable livelihoods.
